Purpose of meeting: Hearing on an appeal of a Domestic Fowl Permit applied for by Mike and Jan Mullin. Permit was originally not granted due to having more than 6 fowl. The appeal was for 9 fowl. Motion by Beth Mantey to allow the appeal for 9 fowl as this is an established flock moving to the community. The owners need to meet all state requirements for importing fowl into the State of South Dakota. As the number of birds is reduced by death or transfer they cannot be replaced until flock size number less than 6 birds. Then the flock shall remain at 6 or less birds going forward. Motion seconded by Krisma DeWitt. Motion carried unanimously.
