Minutes of September 10, 2019 Meeting

The Watertown Animal Control Board met on September 10, 2019 at the Watertown Police Department Conference Room. The meeting was call to order by Mark Rieb at 1:30 pm. Members present included Beth Mantey, Mark Rieb, and Krisma DeWitt. Also attending was the Animal Control Officer Chris Christenson and City Attorney Matt Roby.

Mark Rieb called to order the Appeal Hearing concerning the Vicious Dog declaration of a dog belonging to Jill Warne who had submitted an appeal. Jill Warne, nor representative concerning the appeal were in attendance. Thus, the appeal was denied.

At the completion of the hearing, the Animal Control Board went with other scheduled business. The Agenda was approved with a motion by Beth Mantey and second by Krisma DeWitt.
