CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF
WATERTOWN, SOUTH DAKOTA**

January 11, 2019

The City Council met in special session at 12:00 PM in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 23 2nd Street NE. Mayor Sarah Caron presiding. Present upon roll call: Aldermen Albertsen, Danforth, Lalim, Roby, Solum and Vilhauer. Absent were Aldermen Buhler, Thorson, Weyh and Alderwoman Mantey.

Mayor Caron called for Public Comment. No public comments.

Motion by Vilhauer, seconded by Lalim, to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Motion by Roby, seconded by Albertsen, approving Resolution No. 19-02 approving the settlement of the collective bargaining negotiations between the City of Watertown and the Local Union 2488 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO. Motion carried.
