History of the St. Pauli Lutheran Congregation (1883-1953)

The events of the past are always colored by the heritage which preceded them. This is also true of the beginning and periodic growth of the St. Pauli Evangelical Lutheran Church.

The immigrants to the United States from the Scandinavian countries carried with them a thorough knowledge of God and faith in him. As they settled in their new country, they could not forget the spiritual heritage of the past. Sometimes groups would gather in a home or school house to share the Word of God.

The history of the St. Pauli congregation has its beginning in the year of 1883, when nine men met for the purpose of organizing a congregation. These men were Anders Aaby, Ingebrigt Loveng, Hans A. Wibeto, John J. Ustrud, Ole H. Wibeto, Andreas Stuverud, Peder Markrud, Johannes Aaby and John Stromme.

The locality where the St. Pauli Church is located was settled in the years 1881-1883. The majority of the settlers were of Norwegian descent, the sons and daughters of immigrants of older settlements.

The first pastor to visit the settlement was Rev. L.O. Sherven. It was under the guidance of Rev. Anders Nilsen that the congregation was organized on April 3, 1883, by nine men signing a declaration combining and constituting themselves into the St. Pauli Norwegian Evangelical Lutheran Congregation, acknowledging the Holy Scripture as the only rule and guide for faith, doctrine and life.

Rev. Sherven served the new congregation until Rev. Nilsen was called as pastor by the St. Pauli and Helgen congregations. The congregations were to provide transportation for the pastor and services were held one a month in the homes of the members.

The Ustrud schoolhouse was used for worship for a time after it was built but there was a longing in the hearts of the settlers for a Church building. On July 14, 1883, the congregation held a meeting and selected the present site for cemetery and Church building. In 1886, both the Wheatland and the St. Pauli Ladies' Aids were organized with the primary object of raising funds for a Church building. During the summer of 1886?? the congregation took subscriptions for building and during the summer of 1890, the Church was built at a cost of \$1,304.65.

In 1892, began a trial period for the congregation. The new Church was struck by lightning and burned to the ground. Rev. Nilsen contracted a serious illness that later resulted in his death. The years of 1893-1895 were dry ones and the farmers of the community contacted many debts, therefore thoughts of rebuilding the Church took the background for several years. However, the thoughts of rebuilding were not dead and the Ladies' Aids worked steadily towards raising money for a new Church. A young people's society was organized in 1896 to raise money for the same purpose. In 1899, a subscription was taken and in the fall of 1900, the cornerstone of the new Church was laid by Rev. Granskou, who gave the congregation temporary service during Rev. Nilsen's illness and also following his death until Rev. Rislov accepted the call in 1893.

In 1901, Rev. Rislov resigned and Rev. John Madsen was called as the new pastor in 1902.

The congregation's societies worked continuously for furnishing of the Church and in 1904, the Church was provided with baptismal font, altar, pulpit and cluster lamps, as well as a Church bell. This Church was constructed by three members of the congregation, Lars Hagen, August Faehn and Halvor Markrud, with the assistance of members.

From that time the congregation developed more and more activity in the Church work outside the congregation and in ???tain years the congregations' local expenses were exceeded by contributions to outside activities.

Rev. Madsen resigned in 1912 and Rev. John Haanstad assumed the charge the same year. He served as pastor until his death in 1923. Rev. E. Jorgenson then served temporarily until Rev. John Vold was installed as pastor in 1924.

On October 5, 1924, the Young People's Society was reorganized as the St. Pauli Luther League, and in 1927, the two aids were combined into one society in the name of St. Pauli Ladies Aid. In that year a Church basement was built at a cost of \$2,19????and the aid provided \$1,328 of that amount and have since held their meetings there. In later years the Luther League installed a Delco light plant and also purchased a piano for the Church.

Rev. Vold resigned in 1930 and Rev. C.K.Malmin accepted the call and was installed in August 1930. Rev. Malmin served the congregation for over six years and resigned Oct. 21, 1936, to accept a call to Raymond, WA.

Rev. L.J.Odland served temporarily until Rev. A.H. Holm was installed as pastor on October 24, 1937. Pastor Holm served the congregation until Nov. 1941, when he accepted a call to Arlington, SD.

Rev. Hofstad temporarily served as pastor until August 1942, when Rev. Harold Engh came to serve as permanent pastor. On June 17, 1944, during Pastor Engh's pastorate, a tornado swept through the Florence area destroying the parish parsonage and with it all of the ministerial records of the parish. Upon quick action by the trustees for the four congregations of our parish, the M.F. Heintz residence in Florence was purchased for a parsonage on June 19, 1944.

Rev. Engh served as pastor until Oct. 5, 1952, when he accepted a call to Fertile, MN. The parish was without the services of a pastor until the present pastor, Rev. Kenneth Stangeland was installed on July 26, 1953.

During the period the parish was without the services of a regular pastor, services were conducted by students from the St. Paul Theological Seminary and in many instances neighboring pastors were called upon.

The congregation has been conscious of its duty in extending the Kingdom through the teaching of the Word by maintaining Sunday School, vacation Bible school and confirmation instruction.

During the first 25 years, the regular services and other Church work were carried on exclusively in the Norwegian language. However, English gradually came into use and for a time one half of the regular services were in English and in 1941, the Norwegian services were discontinued.

Down through the years the congregation has had choirs that have furnished cheer and edification to Church services.

The ministerial records show that during the first fifty years 491 children have been baptized, 318 young people confirmed, 75 couples united in marriage and 165 laid to rest in the cemetery. Accurate records beyond the first fifty years are not available due to the loss of all ministerial records by the Florence tornado. At the present time, St. Pauli has approximately 175 confirmed members.

An item of interest is the record of the first confirmation class of the St. Pauli Church. The first confirmation was held on August 7, 1887, by Rev. Anders Nilsen. The members of that class were: Tom Hagen, Mrs. Frederick Faehn, Anna Josephine Knudson, Susan Bergen, Bertha Fjelstad, Anton Urevig, Oscar Hogstad, Annie Hogstad, Minnie Jameson, Mrs. Inga Sakariason, Carrie Loveng, Andrew Hegg and Tom Bergen.

The first persons to be baptized in the present Church were Ida Ekse and Halmer Wibeto.

The only son of the congregation to be ordained into the ministry is Rev. Elmer Larson, a grandson of E.T. Hegna. Rev. Larson is presently the pastor at Ada, MN.

In 1949, the Church basement and the interior of the Church proper were redecorated. This project was financed by the Ladies' Aid and the work was donated by members of the congregation under the direction of Horace Ustrud and Pastor Engh. In 1948, the R.E.A.

constructed power lines past the Church and the Church was rewired for connection to the R.E.A.

The present Board of Officers of the Church are: Trustees: Bennet Haugen, Louis Munson, Theo. Lovick, Oscar Eik and Lawrence Hagen. Secretary: Aldrow Kinstad. Treasurer: Adolph Hogstad. Custodian: Halmer Wibeto. Organist Stella Ihlen.

Today as we observe the 70th anniversary of our congregation, we bow in humble gratitude to God who has sustained and blessed us through the years. We are thankful for the faithful servants who have served us. We are thankful for our house of worship and the sacred memories attached to it. But most of all we are thankful that “we are God’s house of living stones, built for His habitation.” May we ever be that. It is our prayer for the future that God will keep alive in us the living faith in Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior.

History of the St. Pauli Ladies Aid

Could we turn back the pages of time to a certain afternoon in March, 1886, we might look in on a small, but earnest group of women meeting together at the Mads Fiksdal home. The purpose—To see what could be done about starting a Ladies Aid where the women could work together to sew and knit garments later to be sold and the money to go toward helping to build a church. A church they might call their own! Where they might hear the Word of God preached, where they might blend their voices with others in the beloved hymns of the church and last but not least, their children could receive Christian instruction.

There were four women present at that first meeting: namely, Ingeranna Fiksdal, Guri Langeland, Ingeberg Stormo and Margrethe Fosse. Mrs. Langeland was chosen as the first leader. They called themselves, “The Wheatland Ladies Aid.”

The ladies came to the meetings by whatever means they could, lumber wagons, even drawn by oxen was not an uncommon sight. If it were not too far they walked. Three or four miles did not stop them from being present. This work they were doing was important. They were helping to build a church on the prairie where they and their children after them might worship God.

At a 17th of May Festival held at the Ustrud school house in 1887, Pastor Nilsen suggested that the ladies south of the Church start another “Aid” as the distance between those up north and those on the south side was too great for them to get together, considering the means of transportation in those days.

So on the first Thursday in June 1887, a group of women met in the Halvor Okland home and the St. Pauli Ladies Aid was organized. The charter members were: Mrs. Hans Wibeto, Mrs. E.T.Hegna, Mrs. Andreas Hogstad, Mrs. Hans Ustrud, Mrs. Andreas Kinstad, Mrs. Andreas Stuverud, Mrs. Anton Haugen and Mrs. Halvor Okland. Mrs. Okland became the first President, she and her family however, moved away the following year.

The purpose of this new “Aid” was chiefly at first to help build and furnish the church. Their earliest method of securing money was by making garments. At the meeting every one was busy sewing or knitting. Goods was purchased by the yard, garments were cut out and each one took material home to sew also. Every summer or fall a bazaar was held and the money was turned over to be used for the church.

These women, too, came to the meetings by any means available at that time. Many walked and as they walked they continued to knit, so no time was wasted.

Besides all the work done and contributions made to the local church these aids have supported both the Foreign and Home Missions generously.

The two aids joined in May, 1927, under the name of the St. Pauli Ladies Aid and a new constitution was written and adopted.

The first meeting was held in the new church basement Nov. 3, 1927.

Three golden wedding have been celebrated in our church, namely: Mr. and Mrs. Anton Haugen, Mr. and Mrs. J.J.Lee and Mr. and Mrs. P.J. Munson. Over 90 babies have been enrolled

in the cradle roll. Constance Vold, daughter of Rev. And Mrs. J.O.Vold, was the first baby enrolled. Each member received a Testament as they graduated from the cradle roll.

In February, 1949, plans were made to completely refinish the interior of the church and the basement dining room walls. Pastor Engh and Horace Ustrud drew the plans and the men of the congregation helped with the work.

In 1950, we discontinued paying monthly dues. We now give the Worship Offerings. The Cheer Committee remembers the sick and shut-ins with gifts, flowers and words of comfort.

The Goodhue-St. Pauli Brotherhood

On Monday evening, October 22, 1945, some of the men of Goodhue and St. Pauli Congregations met together with the Pastor Rev. H.M. Engh and Rev. A.E. Iverson, Executive Secretary of the Lutheran Brotherhood, in a joint session at the St. Pauli Church to discuss the feasibility of organizing a Lutheran Brotherhood.

On Oct. 29, 1945, a committee met to lay the preliminary plans for the organization of the Brotherhood.

The programs have been instructive and up-lifting and often have been highlighted with addresses by outstanding speakers and featured by colorful and educational slides and movies. The annual Father-Son Banquet has been an event of good fellowship.
