RULES

Sportsmanship is a must from all players, parents, spectators and coaches.

Rolling schedule will be used after first scheduled game times are announced.

Each game will be played inside the Main Gym of PLWC. All games will be played in the half court.

Teams are required to wear the same colored jersey or t-shirt.

All games must start with 3 players from each team.

Game balls will be provided. Youth Grades 2-8, Girls High School through Women's Post College will use a 28.5 basketball. Boys Grade 9 - Men's Post College will use an official size basketball.

All Courts will have a scorekeeper/court monitor. Youth courts will have an official. Adult courts will call their own fouls. Any disagreements will result in a redo of the possession.

All non-shooting and missed shooting fouls on the defense are 1 point and 1 free throw for the offensive player who is fouled. Any foul on a made basket, the respected points count plus the offensive team receives possession of the ball.

Offensive fouls are 1 point for the defense and the defensive team receives possession of the basketball.

Games must be won on a scored basket, not on a foul call.

All jump balls go to the defensive team.

Scoring: Inside the arc is 1 point, outside arc is 2 points

Youth Games Grades 1-6 will play to 15. Win by 2 or first team to 20.

Youth Games Grade 7 & 8 will play to 20, win by 2 or first to 25.

High School, College and Post College will play to 30, win by 2 or first to 35.

Defensive Team on a rebound or steal must return the ball behind the arc by dribbling or passing. Failure to not take it back will result in loss of possession and any points scored during that possession.

After a score or timeout the ball must be checked in by the defensive player to the offensive player. The offensive player may dribble, pass or shoot off the check.

All substitutions must be made during dead ball situations.

Each team will receive two 30 second timeouts per game.

Time Limit is 40 minutes for all games. This includes a warm-up time, time-outs and game time.

In case of tie game at the time limit, it will result in a free throw contest between the two teams.

Free Throws: Grade 2 will have modified free throw line marked by floor tape. All other divisions will shoot from the regulation free throw line.

Grade 2 will play on a 9 ft 6 in hoop. All other divisions will use a regulation 10 ft basket.
